

**REMINDERS FROM THE MUNICIPAL CODE BOOK -**

**SPRING CLEAN-UP AROUND THE LAKE**

In accordance with Chapter 220 of the Municipal Code Book -

**OPEN STORAGE IS PROHIBITED**

This includes, but is not limited to: vehicle parts, machinery, tires or tools; cut brush, tree branches, limbs or timber; boxes, bottles, cans, bricks, barrels; lumber or building materials; or furniture, kitchen appliances.

Materials stored for purpose of construction on the premises may be stored for the length of the time during which a valid building permit exists.

**ABANDONED, DISMANTLED, JUNKED  
OR INOPERABLE VEHICLES OR BOATS**

Any abandoned, dismantled, junked or inoperable vehicle or boat or part thereof located on any property or street which presents a hazard to children, harbors any vegetation, creates a fire hazard, affords a breeding or nesting place for pests or vermin is prohibited.

Any vehicle or boat or part thereof or junk allowed to remain unmoved on any street for forty-eight (48) hours is a public nuisance and is prohibited.

**WEEDS**

Keep your lawns mowed.

Weeds, grass and brush over twelve (12) inches in height is prohibited.

**Note: Our code enforcement officer will be making the rounds to ensure our Lake maintains the high standards we have come to expect.**
