

YARD WASTE PICK-UP IS BACK!

Yard waste will be picked up by EWS, our Trash Service, **starting Monday, July 2nd**.

Every MONDAY when you set your trash at the curb, set out your yard waste too. You can set out up to six (6) bags.

Yard waste must be enclosed in brown paper compost bags or in a polycart provided by EWS. There's a \$3.00 monthly rental fee for the cart, payable to EWS.

Remember - trash and yard waste should be set at curbside no earlier than Sunday night and no later than 7:00 AM Monday morning.

There will be an increase of \$2.43/month on the trash portion of your water bill.

This is a year round service. And at the end of the year, EWS will also collect Christmas trees.

Reminder: EWS defines yard waste as 'mulcher-ready seasonal plant matter'. This means leaves, grass clippings, trimmings from bushes, garden weeds, etc.

Tree limbs may be included but must be cut and tied together in bundles no greater than 4 feet by 2 feet, using only natural fiber rope or twine. EWS will NOT accept nylon rope or wire.

EWS does NOT consider the following as yard waste: firewood, lumber, dirt, rock or landscape timbers.
